

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PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

SBRI is a simple process. Typically competitions are split into two phases. All competitions are based around a market need, which is expressed as a desired outcome, rather than a required specification.

Phase 1 Proposals concentrate on proving the scientific, technical and commercial feasibility of the proposed project. The results of phase 1 determine whether the solution should go further to phase 2 – not all projects will progress to the second phase.

Phase 2 Prototyping is undertaken in phase 2. Projects that successfully complete phase 2 can then be commercialised and offered to government departments and others under a normal procurement process.

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Assessment Criteria

1. How well does the proposal **address the challenge** outlined in the brief? – **25%**
2. What is the degree of **technical challenge** and how **innovative** is the project? – **15%**
3. How significant is the **competitive advantage**, which this technology affords, over existing/alternate technologies that can meet the market needs? – **15%**
4. How appropriate are the **milestones** and evaluation procedures? – **5%**
5. How appropriate is the proposed **development plan**? What are the risks (technical, commercial and environmental) to project success and how effectively will these be managed? – **5%**
6. To what extent does the proposed project have **commercial potential** and does the size of the market justify the investment? – **15%**
7. To what extent does the company and project team appear to have the **right skills and experience** to deliver the intended benefits? – **15%**
8. How appropriate is the proposal financially? **Is the overall budget realistic** and justified in terms of the aims and methods proposed? – **5%**
